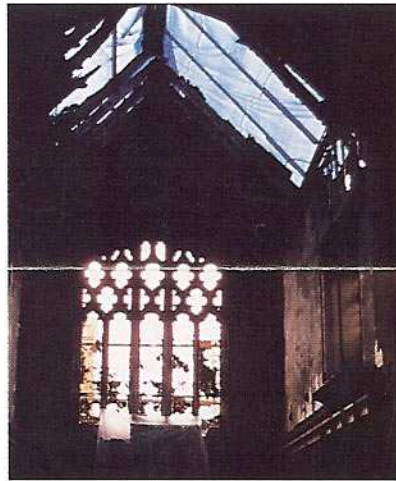

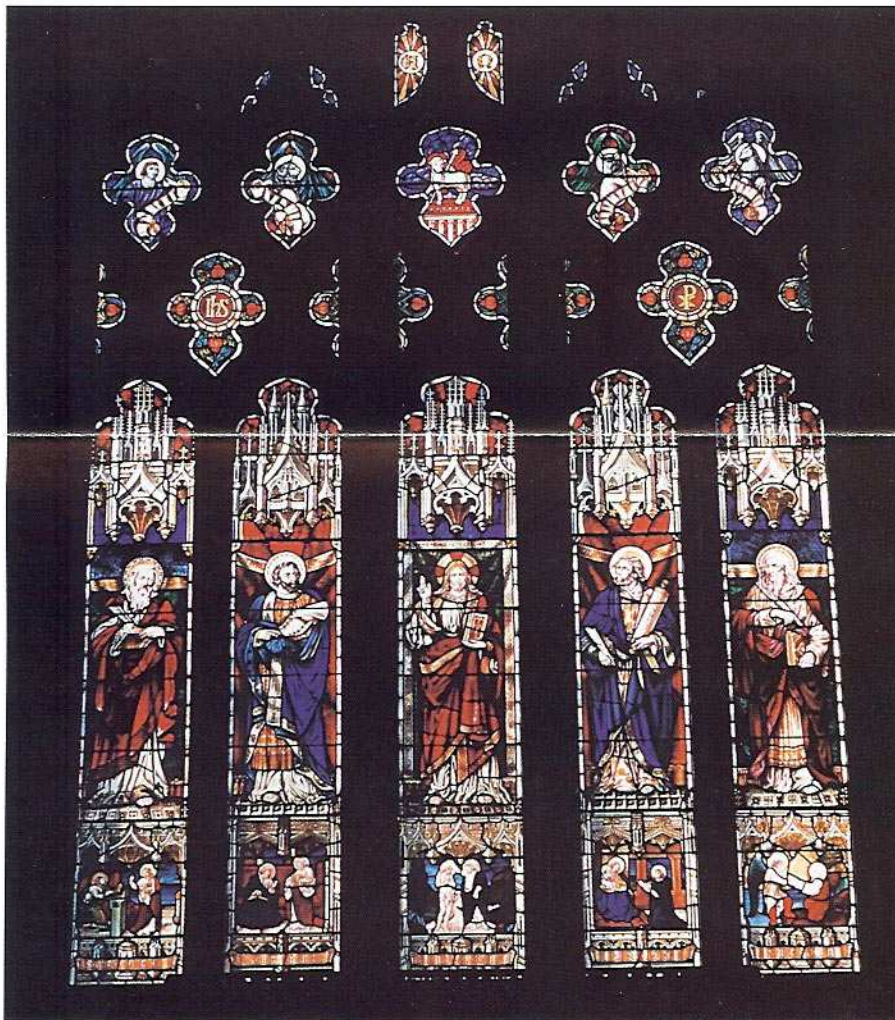

Stained Glass Resources, Inc. chosen to re-create historic windows destroyed by fire

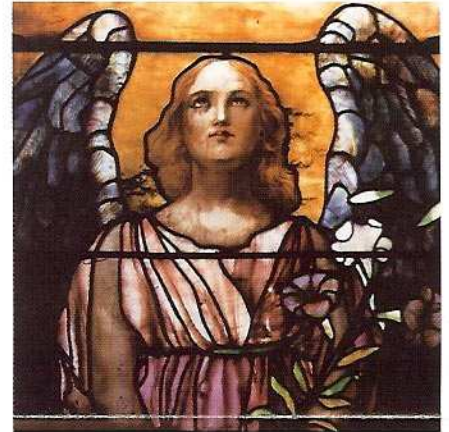
On October 10, 1992, St. John's Episcopal Church of West Hartford, Connecticut was severely damaged by fire. Stained Glass Resources re-created the destroyed windows and completely restored the fire-damaged windows in historically correct detail. Most were superb English-Style Windows from the turn of the Century. The Clerestory Windows were by the Historic Burnham Studio of Boston, Massachusetts.

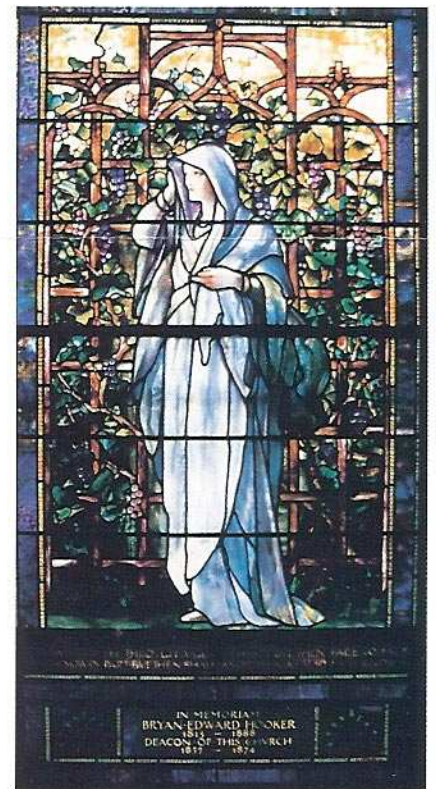


"St. John on the Isle of Patmos", a historic Tiffany Window in memory of the Rev. Wilder Smith.

"Hope", a historic Tiffany Window in memory of the Bryan Edward Hooker.

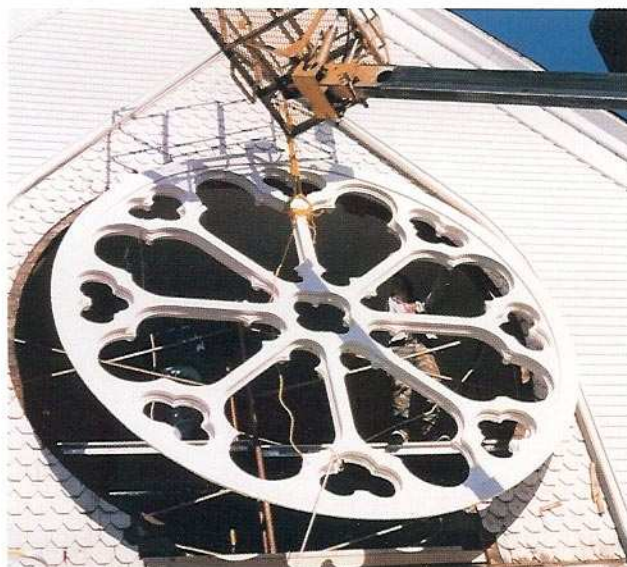

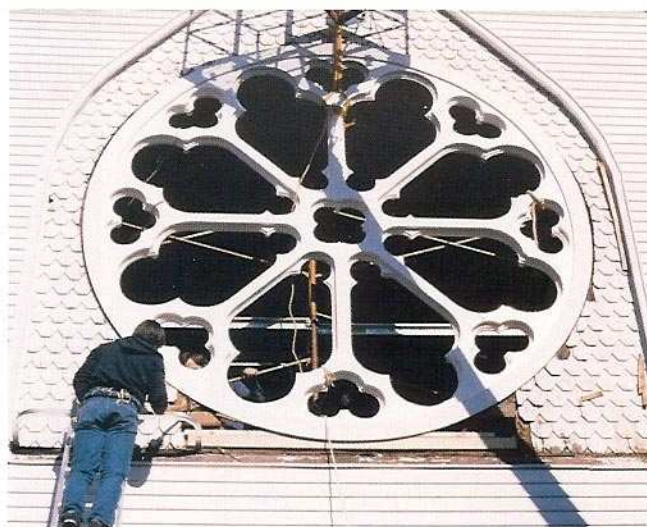
